Christianity



A religion is a set of beliefs held by different people. There are many different religions. This half term we are going to concentrate on Christianity

Islam



People who believe in the religion Christianity are called Christians. Christians may go to church.

An example of a festival celebrated in Islam is Eid-ul-Fitr.

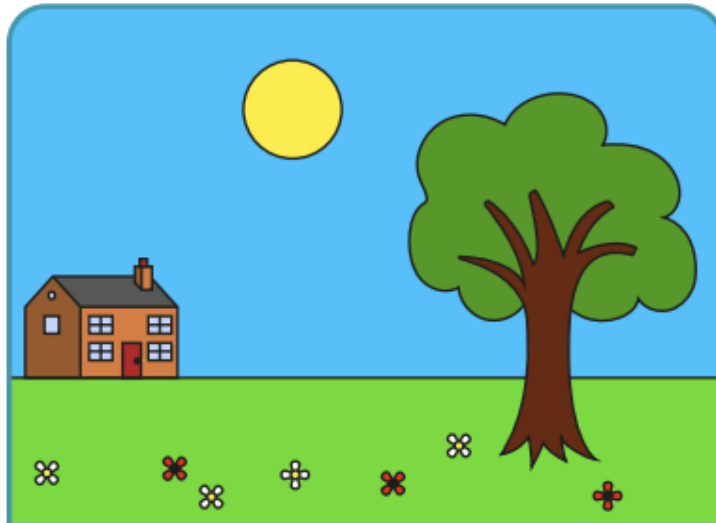
Eid-ul-Fitr is a celebration which marks the end of Ramadan (where Muslims only eat before the sun rises and after the sun sets).

Muslims may celebrate Eid-ul-Fitr by praying, eating a big meal, giving each other presents and visiting friends and family.

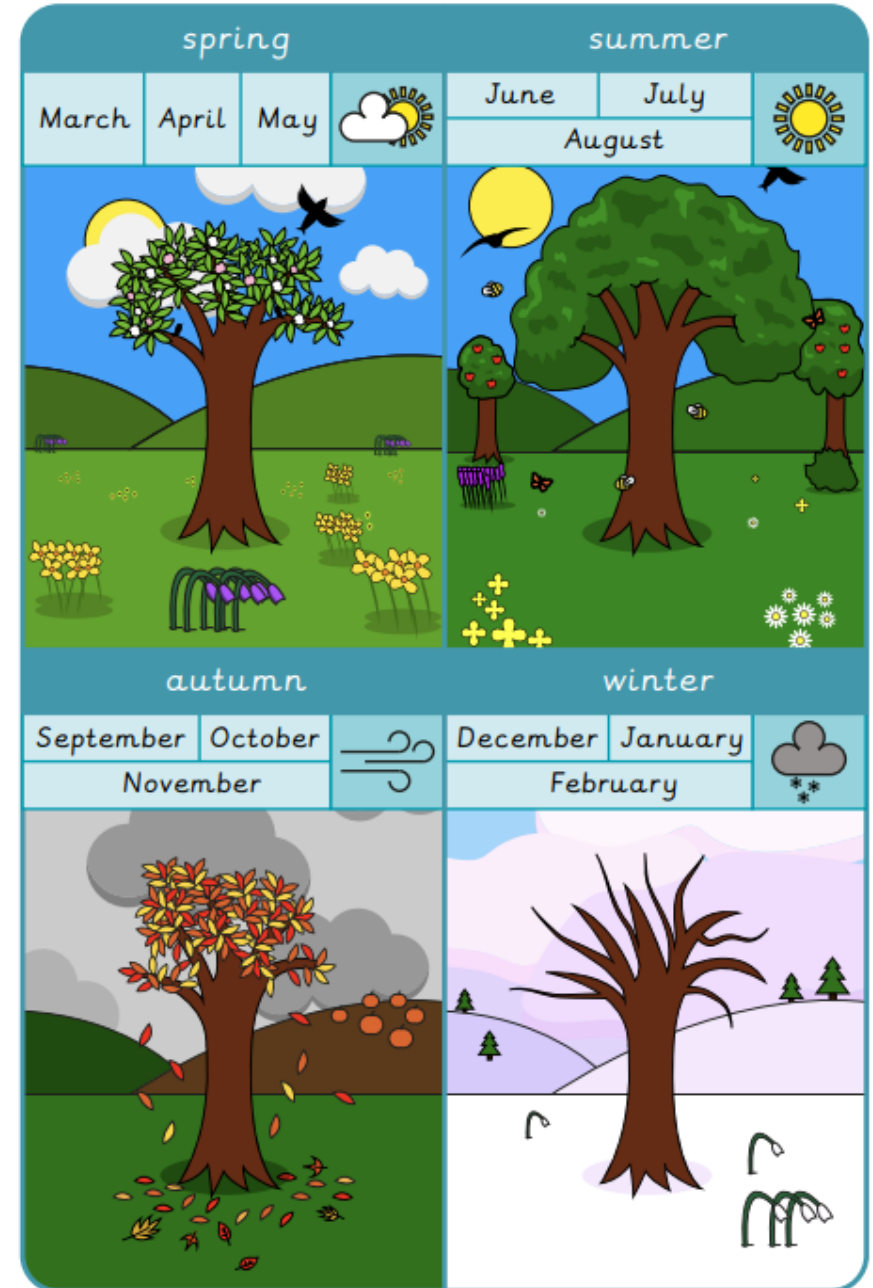

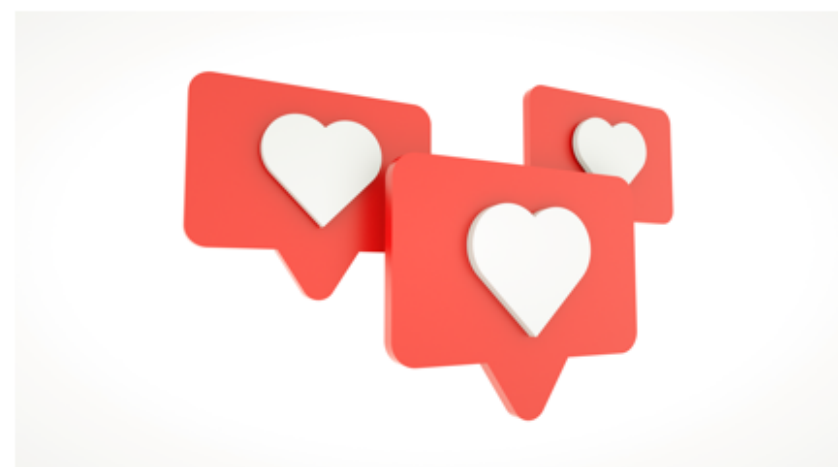







