



Sheringham Curriculum Map – Autumn 2 2023/24



ENGLISH

This half term in English, we will be reading “The Lion, The Witch And The Wardrobe” by C.S. Lewis.

We will base our writing sequences on this book and we will be focussing on portal stories. We will also look at other texts, including wordless picture books, where characters travel into a new world.

GPS

This half term, our core focus will be on word classes. We will learn to identify and use:

- Nouns, verbs and adjectives.
- Adverbs, pronouns and determiners.
- Fronted adverbials.

SCIENCE

This half term, we will be learning about rocks and soil. We will focus on how igneous, metamorphic and sedimentary rocks are formed. We will also be learning about Mary Anning and why she made such a significant contribution to science.

PE

This half term in PE, we will be learning badminton. We will also have a weekly session with our swimming coach.

MATHS

Addition and subtraction:

- Add and subtract numbers with up to four digits using mental and written methods.
- A variety of checking strategies including estimation and using the inverse operation.
- Addition and subtraction in context (for example addition and subtraction of money or distances).

Multiplication and division:

- Sharing and grouping.
- Using arrays to support our understanding of multiplication.
- Using manipulatives, such as place value counters, to introduce the formal methods of division.
- Using supportive strategies to begin learning formal written methods of multiplication.

Times Table Foci:

- 6s, 7s and 9s.

DT

This half term, we will be focussing on creating structures using strong supportive shapes.

We will also learn how to design, build, analyse and improve our pavilion designs.

HUMANITIES (HISTORY)

This half term, we will be focussing on local history. We will be learning about the history of the Royal Air Force in our area.

LATIN

This half term, we will begin studying chapter 2 of our Minimus textbook. We will learn to identify masculine and feminine nouns and we will be introduced to the idea that adjectives must agree with their nouns.

PSHE

This half term, our core learning in PSHE will focus on the idea of celebrating our differences.

MUSIC

This half term, we will be thinking about how music affects our feelings and emotions when we play. We will also be learning to play, improvise and compose using the following notes: C, D, E, F, G, A and B.

RE

This half term, our big question is:
How do Buddhists explain suffering in the world?

COMPUTING

This half term we will be learning about audio (sound) production in our computing lessons.
