












Thornham Homework Grid - Summer 1

<p>Draw a picture a castle and label it.</p> 	<p>Can you find out why knights stopped wearing a full suit of armour and stopped building huge castles?</p> 	<p>Knights had a coat of arms on their shields to show who they were in battle. Can you design your own coat of arms?</p> 
<p>It is now Spring, what flowers can you find in Spring?</p> 	<p>Can you identify and name a variety of common flowers? Can you draw your favourite flower.</p> 	<p>Can you write instructions how to plant a seed.</p> 
<p>Practise learning your doubles to 20.</p> 	<p>Can you make up some word problems to include addition and subtraction. Eg I have 7 sweets and buy 6 more how many sweets do I have? $7 + 6 = 13$.</p> 	<p>On an analogue clock practise reading o'clock, half past times. If you are confident practise quarter past and quarter to.</p>
