







Year 5 Homework Grid – Summer 1

It could be to help other people to learn something that you know well.</p>
<p>Design a symmetrical shield or helmet for a warrior.</p> 	<p>Make a chart with the following three headings solids, liquids and gases. Give a brief description of each one, and find pictures of examples for each state of matter.</p> 	<p>Create a piece of New Media art. Think about using technology to create art, or use one of the styles we have tried in class to create a piece of modern artwork.</p>	<p>Create a Viking menu. Look up what sorts of foods Vikings would have eaten and use those to create your dishes. If you can, taste some of the foods and write a review.</p>
