Getting ready for school

Please ensure your children are in the correct uniform for school, with blue school jumpers, not random coloured tops or plain blue or black ones for PE. Maths this term

In Maths we will be following the White Rose Scheme. The order of topics is:

Place Value

The four operations

Fractions

Measuring: converting units

We will also be doing daily Numeracy Ninjas.

It is crucial for improving fluency in Maths that the children know their times tables and they are expected to practise on the Tackling Tables website at least three times a week.

English this term

We will be studying a book called 'Number the Stars' by Lois Lowry this term. It is a book about the lives of two families set in the second world war in Denmark and events surrounding the Holocaust of Jewish people living in Denmark. This links well to our History topic later on in the term.

We will also look at WW2 poetry in November.

We will be doing phonics and spelling through the Read, Write Inc scheme on a daily basis.

It is expected that your child reads daily at home and that you sign their reading record to show you know that they have. Every time their book is signed three times they will receive a raffle ticket to go into a half-termly draw for an Amazon voucher from me.



Forthcoming events

Year 6 children will be making decisions about going on the residential in March – it is useful to start paying in small installments to make it more affordable for you.

Also, Y6 parents, you will need to be applying for high school places by the end of October, you should receive information directly about this, and will be invited to visits – it is parents' responsibility to organise and apply for high schools.
